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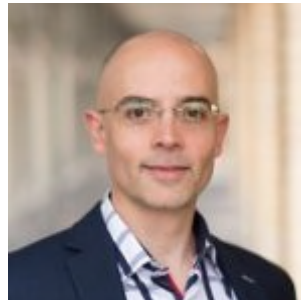


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GL2022 Conference Opening Address Publishing Grey Literature in the Digital Century National Library of Medicine, USA • December 5-6, 2022



Markus Stocker is head of the Knowledge Infrastructures Research Group at the TIB Leibniz Information Centre for Science and Technology and a research associate at the Leibniz University Hannover. He holds a PhD in Environmental Informatics from the University of Eastern Finland; a MSc in Environmental Science from the University of Eastern Finland; and a Diploma (MSc) in Informatics from the University of Zurich, Switzerland. His

research interests lie at the intersection between research infrastructures and research communities, and how such infrastructures acquire, maintain, and share scientific knowledge about human and natural worlds. Prior to TIB, Markus held a postdoctoral research associate position at PANGAEA, the Data Publisher for Earth & Environmental Science, at the MARUM Center for Marine Environmental Sciences, University of Bremen, Germany. As a member of the Research Data Alliance (RDA), Markus co-chairs the WG Persistent Identification of Instruments. Markus has several years of professional experience in software development and semantic technologies, with positions at Hewlett Packard Labs, Bristol, UK and Clark & Parsia, Washington DC, USA. He enjoys working together with scientists and has experiences with aerosol scientists, biogeochemists, and agricultural scientists. He collaborates with environmental research infrastructures, in particular ACTRIS (European Research Infrastructure for the observation of Aerosol, Clouds, and Trace gases), ICOS (European Integrated Carbon Observation System) and NEON (US National Ecological Observatory Network). Guidelines

Persons who seek to present a poster during GL2022 are invited to submit an English abstract between 250-300 words. The abstract should describe the project, activity, information product or service. The abstract should likewise include a title, name(s) of the creator(s) and their full address information. Abstracts are an important source of information available prior to the conference that is accessible to conference delegates and the international grey literature community.

Due Date for Submission

Timely registration is a guarantee for your placement on the conference program. The conference venue is able to accommodate a limited number of physical posters that will be mounted on display panels allowing for optimal viewing. Abstracts in MSWord should be emailed to conference@textrelease.com on or before **November 15th 2022**. Those submitting poster abstracts will receive verification upon receipt accompanied by further guidelines for posters, submission of slides, Conference Registration, etc.

Poster Presentations

On the afternoon of Day One, each person presenting a poster will have 3-4 minutes in the Main Conference Hall to introduce their work. The Poster Session will continue on the morning of Day Two, where the presenters will be able to meet with delegates and participants in an informal setting. In order to guarantee a backup of your presentation, you are required to submit an MP4 pre-recorded video of your poster presentation by **November 15th 2022**.

Poster Prize 2022

Those presenting conference posters are also eligible for the Poster Prize 2022 that will be awarded during the conference Closing Session. Posters will be judged onsite by a panel of jurors based on their innovative content, relevance to the conference topics, graphic design, and accompanying abstract. The results of prior distance balloting by members and subscribers to GreyNet International will likewise factor into judging the conference posters.

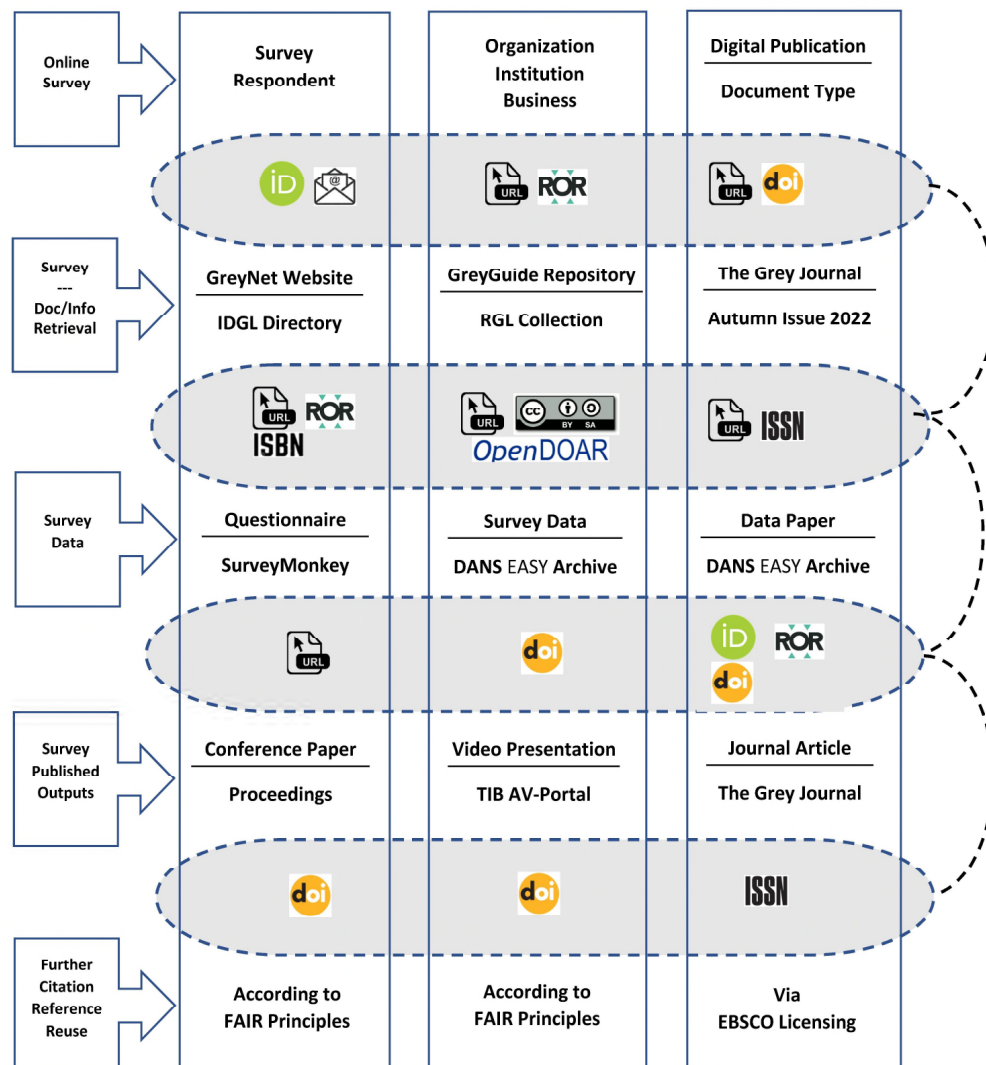

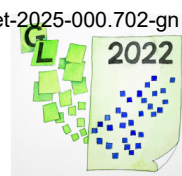

Conference Announcement



For over three decades, authors and researchers in the field of information have addressed the many challenges in publishing grey literature. In so doing, they have confronted core issues. Is grey literature published literature, and if so, how is it published; how does it differ from commercially published literature; and foremost how can it stay abreast with the technological developments that will ensure its access, uses, and preservation for scholarly research and citizen science well into the 21st Century.

The response to such questions lies in the collaboration and integrated roles of publishing bodies and their affiliate libraries and information centers, where grey literature is produced and processed. While currentness is inherent to grey literature in that it is situated at the cutting edge of research, and while it is comprehensive in that it captures the corpus of both the research process and issuing results, grey literature publishing often lacks the financial resources and technical expertise afforded commercial publishers.

Due consideration should be given to shared workflows grounded in an understanding and commitment that production and publication constitute two integral parts in publishing today's digital grey literature. GL2022 will address the components of such shared workflows embedded in FAIR data principles and implemented by diverse communities of practice in this our digital Century.

ISTI Open Portal: a tool for Open Access

The scientific production of CNR researchers is deposited in the central institutional archive called "People". It stores metadata and exposes the bibliographic records only. Accordingly, it does not offer public search, browse, statistic portals.

ISTI OA Policy since January 2018

"The metadata and a digital version of any published or unpublished research product must be deposited in People and made available by IOP".

IOP is an instance of RepOSGate, a software able to collect metadata records from a repository, enrich and make them searchable and usable. The contents gathered from People - via OAI-PMH set - are enhanced and interlinked with information from scholarly communication services and resources (e.g. the OpenAIRE Research Graph, ScholeXplorer).
